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Wood Hub, a sustainable, innovative and convivial office building, built by and for employees

With the construction of their new office building, the multidisciplinary industrial group CFE, BPI Real Estate, BPC Group and Wood Shapers are pooling their skills and aiming for sustainability, innovation and the well-being of its employees. BPI Real Estate oversees the development and VMA will install special techniques and Smart Building software (VMANAGER). Finally, BPC Group and Wood Shapers oversee the construction process. Currently still under construction, it should be ready by autumn 2023.



Innovating to move forward but also to contribute to a sustainable life together: Wood Hub is the realization of this vision. The office building will be located at the Van Nieuwenhuyselaan in Audergem and has a surface area of 6,700 m². It was designed by Archi2000. CFE and its entities BPI Real Estate, BPC Group and Wood Shapers will set up there.

The emphasis is on collaboration, interaction and creativity. The design clearly shows this: from the common areas on the ground floor to the co-working spaces, including the lobby adjoining a splendid outdoor terrace. BREEAM Outstanding and WELL Platinum

With Wood Hub, the group aims to obtain the BREEAM Outstanding and the WELL Platinum certificates. They guarantee durability with attention paid to the well-being, health and safety of users. The use of Smart Building systems offers users a flawless experience. Nearly Zero Energy Building

Wood Hub, an NZEB building (Nearly Zero Energy Building), truly is the building of the future. It has a CREE structure of mixed wood and concrete. It will be heated and cooled by using geothermal energy and heat pumps, in addition to 120 kilowatt photovoltaic panels. These systems combined does not require the building to rely on fossil fuels. Moreover, its location, only 800 metres away from the current head office and close to the Demey metro station, will encourage the use of soft mobility among employees.
